N A R R A T I V E

This month was another of inactivity. As in the last four months, we still have plenty of pilots and airplanes but the drain on our enlisted personnel, which we have felt before, was felt again this month. We are still flying just enough to get our required flying time. Most of the flying time was logged in L-4's, with a few hours in the L-5 and the L-47. The usual ground training of pre-flighting and maintenance was carried out.

With the coming of the new year, Lt. Hamilton and Lt. Klumpp returned from rest leave at the Riviera at Cannes, France. Other men, both Officers and enlisted men, were at the Leave Centers in Switzerland, and still others at the Group ski lodge, located a few miles northeast of the Base. This rotation of men on leave continued throughout the month. The men on leave are all busy now upon their return, as all the men who don't have regular jobs, are now pickeling all of the Squadron airplanes that are in storage. One would have a hard time telling that these men pickeling, were none other than a crew of enlisted mechanics. Actually though, they are the officers that used to keep em flying. The boys are doing a good job, and ought to finish the job of pickeling sometime in the Spring.

On or about the 22nd. of the month, another large shipment of enlisted men left the Group to form a packet headed for the I.I. This took the 52 and 53 pointers, which included most of our remaining experienced mechanics. This last shipment will be felt very much by the engineering department. In turn, we received some replacements direct from the States. They have a point score range from C to 8 points. These men are eager, but they are short on experience, and we are't doing enough operating for them to learn too quickly. In another month, we won't have an experienced man left on the flight line.

One of the biggest events of the month, came with the return of Lt. Jay O. Mc Call from his R&R leave to the States. The leave evidently was a good one for Mac. He got married, and really looks in fine shape. According to Mac, we should all stay over here a few more months. Things are really tough back home today. The prices of goods are high, and one just can't find clothes to buy. This Army life and Army pay are O.K. Ask Mac.

Group down in Inns, Austria. These two pilots were Lt. Jack Mass and Lt. Bill Higby. We will miss these two boys greatly. Lt. Mass was one of the slickest men in the group, and one of the few combat pilots left over here. Lt. Higby has been with us since the closing days of the war with Germany. They were both very popular in the Squadron and the Group, and we were sure sorry to them go.

One of the most important events of the month came up when all of our Squadron enlisted men were transferred to the 396th. Fighter Squadron. We now have one enlisted man in the Squadron. He works in the orderly room, and keeps the Officers records in shape. This new set up will probably stay in effect until we get enough enlisted men to make up more than one Squadron of full strength.

Except for the events mentioned, nothing out of the ordinary happened this month. Each day saw the same old routine carried out. Visits to the Red Cross "Bar Harbor" were many, the new "Thunderbolt Club" in Straubing was busy each night, and the Officers frequented their own Club here on base. Special Services provided us all with a couple of stage shows in the new theater too. January was a good month, but we all are glad to see the months pass by us over here.

REVISION OF TRAINING PROGRAM

Training during the first part of the month was chiefly at a standstill. No one knew whether we were to continue on the old training program, or that a new one would be substituted. Finally in the latter part of the month a "back" memorandum arrived and operations personnel set to work establishing new programs and revising the old charts for another training program.

The new program is very similar to the old one with some missions deleted and changes in some of the ones to be continued. These changes involved both addition of hours for some missions and the removal of other hours in others. Due to the lack of personnel there have been insufficient planes to accomplish the command desired percentage of training scheduled for the month of January.

There was very little snow to prevent operations but the weather was poor a large part of the time. The increasing length of daylight hours per day is already being felt and flying hours have been extended until 1630 hours.

Again this month most of the "participation" of the pilots was done in the "light" airplanes.

Training started and was accomplished for the month of January according to Memo 50-1, sq. III 288, dated 8 January 1946.





## NARRATIVE

During the month of July the 395th Fighter Squadron flew 105 training missions without mishap.
