Narretive
Covering the Month of February 1945

ALG Y-34, Metz, France -- (Feb 1) -- The month opened with a day of fog and rain which did not permit our planes to take off.

Our basket bell season got off to a flying start tonight with two games. They were played in the gymnasium in metz under somewhat adverce conditions. Moisture from the walls and ceiling made the floor plippery and hazardous. In the first game, the 397th enlisted men beat "A" team of the 382nd Service Squadron by a score of 27\_to 16. 3gt Meath took scoring honors with 14 points to his credit. The team consisted of Sgt Heath, Sgt Floyd, Sgt W. J. Lewis, Sgt J. Nelson, Sgt D. E. Nelson, Sgt Lenshan, Opl Earret, Sgt R. L. Bernard, Opl Hilgendorf, Opl Katz, Sgt Watson, Sgt Wych, Sgt Hamilton, and Sgt Drake.

The Officers Team of the 397th trounced "2" team of the 302nd Service Team Squadron 29 to 7. Scoring honors were evenly divided among Capt Johnson, who also acts as coach, Lt Clary and Lt Woodworth with six points each. Lt Hamilton, Lt Frisbie and Lt Yandel followed close behind with four points each. Others on the team were: Major Tuite, Lt Uterhert, Lt Arledge, Lt Kalen, Lt Leevoy, and Lt Fatrick.

Winth Air Force Special Orders No. 32 of this date announces the promotion of Lt Kerr to the grade of Captain.

FDB 2 — The weather cleared up today permitting the squadron to get in two missions. The first of these cut rail lines in several places near Koblenz and destroyed over thirty railroad cars by strafing. Mission pilots were: Krause, Koenig, Clary, Uterhart, Bauer, Le Grand, Prisbie, Wright.

The second mission beat up the marshalling yard at Wetzlar. Major Carbine and Lt Arledge hit a fuel storage dump causing large fires and smoke. Lt Barker destroyed a locometive and six cars and Lt Kerr six cars. Lt must hit the eastern choke point of the yard. On the mission were: Carbine, Arledge, Weinstein, horowitz, Barker, hord, kerr, and Hunt.

Squadron Special Orders No. 3 of this date releives Capt Johnson from his duties as unit Soldier Voting Officer.

FEB 5 -- Inclement weather prevented flying.
Group Special Orders No. 7 of 22 Jan 1945 sent Lt Clary to Paris for seven days for instruction in bombing tactics.

\*\* GROUP RECEIVES DISTIN\*- Continued bad weather, no flying.

\*\*\* GUISHED UNIT CITATION Ninth Air Force General Orders No. 14,

\*\*\* of 22 January 1945 received today, contain the

\*\*\* Distinguished Unit Citation for the 368th group,

as announced in last months history. The citation reads in partl "For outstanding performance of duty in action against the enemy on 3 September 1944, \* \* \* in vicinity of mons.

The Group destroyed 262 motor transport and damaged 30 more, \* \* 230 horse drawn vehicles were destroyed as well as an undetermined number of enemy personnel. \* \* \* a staggering blow to the enemy's supply of armored vehicles and transport."

FWB 5 -- Bad weather continued to ground all planes. A new Group policy started last month has at last given our ground personnel a long

awaited opportunity to visit Paris. One Officer and three enlisted men from each unit leave for  $P_{\rm a}$ ris every two days and spend sixty hours in the city. It provides welcome releif from our somewhat drab existance here at Metz as well as an opportunity to taste the many pleasures for which Paris is famous.

Group Special Orders No. 10 of 31 Jan 1945 received today send it Hamilton to Paris for six days in connection with making a broadcast on a Minth A.F. radio program. We understand that Lt Hamilton was chosen because his is the highest total of enemy transport destroyed of any pilot in the Minth Air Force.

FER 6 -- The squadron was sent out today to attack the A/P at Giebelstadt. Clusters of frag bombs were used so that it was difficult to assess damage. One dispersal area with about 15 planes present was thought to have been pretty thomoughly pounded, however. Mission pilots were: Carbine, Tuite, Baker, Uterhart, Lewis, Halpin, Sharp, Thornton, Herr, munt, Soo, and Fein.

FEB 7 -- Foor visibility again halted operations today.

MESS -- Two successful missions marked today's operations. The first of these concentrated on a small marshalling yard where an unknown number of cars were destroyed as well well as a roundhouse and several small buildings in the vicinity. Mission pilots were: Krause, Kostrath, Baker, Horowitz, Barker, Halpin, Fendel, Leavoy, Morlacher, Koenig, Weinstein, and Wright.

The second mission took a large toll of Jerry's motorized transportation. Major Carbine destroyed 5 vehicles and damaged 20. Lt Lewis destroyed one half track and damaged 15 and teamed up with Lt hord dawged nine more. Lt Kerr damaged 15 goods cars, destroyed three tanks, eleven half tracks, ten vehicles, and a gas truck and, teamed up with Lt Hunt, damaged twenty more vehicles. Lt Kerr also damaged fifteen houses. Quite a one man eir force! Lt Hunt destroyed two more tanks and still others were scattered among the remaining members of the squadron. Those on the mission were: Carbine, Fuite, Hogan, Malen, Lewis, Hord, Friebie, Patrick, Kerr, Hunt, Soo, and Fein.

F48 9 -- Today's mission started out after a rail bridge but was unable to attack because of weather, instead they bombad a small town near Delifeld where 16 housed were destroyed, six of which blew up. Ten more were left aurning. The railroad was also out. Mission yilots were: Carbine, Tuite, Frisbie, Wright, Lewis, Loenig, Sharp, Thornton, Kerr, Hunt, Soo and Fain.

Group Special Orders No. 14 of this date send Capt Driscoll to Faris for seven days to have a camara installed in a P-47. Lt Wright is sent to Burtonwood U.K. to pick up a P-47. Four new pilots are assigned to our squadron by the same order. They are: lst It Whitney W. Brayton, and 2nd Lts James W. Chancellor, Marion L. Deputy, and Richard G. Elliott.

FEB 10 -- Today's mission pilots' bombed a bridge near Laveling. Two direct hits were doored on the bridge of which Lt Bauer scored one. There was also one cut on the railroad and several on nearby roads. On the mission were: Krause, Le Grand, Clary, Horowitz, Bauer, Loavoy, Hogan, Kalen, Barker, Halpin, Yandel, and Uterhart.

Squadron Special Orders No. 4 of this date appoint Lt Friebie Squadron Court of

Inquiry Officer for alleged violations of the Geneva Convention.

Report Number 41 of the IX TAC Victory Gredits Board places in the confirmed category the damage of one ME 109 on 8 Dec 44 north of Duren by Major Richard E. Leary. It places in the unconfirmed category the damage of one FW 190 west of Cologne by Capt Damae in addition to an ME 109 destroyed on the same date as awarded on Report No. 36. The claim of Lt Lewis to one ME 109 damaged northeast of Duren is confirmed and the claims of Lt & D Sharp to one ME 109 damaged west of Cologne is placed in the unconfirmed category, both of 8 Dec 1944.

Fig 11 -- Low-hanging clouds and fog prevented a take-off today.

Group received several copies of Ninth Air Force 2nd Phase Interpretation Report U310/D SHECIAL today which give dramatic photographic proof of the tremendous destruction wrought in the marshalling yards at Neunkirchen by pilots of this squadron on 15 January 1945. Dur pilots reported an explosion of enormous proportions, but this photographic evidence exceeds in magnitude even their most hopeful reports. The pictures show an area of devastation 55 by 40 yards in extent, with many railroad cars destroyed and four rail lines cut and torn up for a length of 120 feet. It seems probable that a train load of bombs or torpedos was hit. A copy of this report is included with this history.

FEB 12 -- All planes were grounded again today. Group Special Orders No. 15 of this date send Lt R D Sharp to Burtonwood U. K. to pick up a P-47.

The same orders award the Good Conduct Medal to the following enlisted men for - "fidelity through faithful and exact performances of duty, efficiency -- behavior -- such as to deserve emulation: "S/Sgts James N. McKenzie, Vernon D. Saunders, Sgts Merlin J. Dickvoss, Raymond C. Hofknecht, William E. Murray, George W. Savage, Opls Charles W. Bardsley, Opl Irvin M. Beiner, Esrnard Eronheim, Charles D. Gill, August J. Menkens, and Pfcs Joseph D. Maria, William T. McGoy, Michael Signe, Daniel E. White.

MEB 15 -- Capt Krause and Lt Iandel went on a weather recce mission early this morning during which they strafed and destroyed the locomotive and several cers of a train near Trier.

The second mission was one of futile direction and misdirection by a number of controllers. Our planes wandered around over most of western dermany over a 10/10 overcast which prevented them from finding and suitable targets. Finally they dropped their bembs on a small town seen through a break in the clouds, and returned home somewhat disgusted. On this mission were : krause, ledrand, Yandel, Patrick, Lewis, Nord, Frisbie, Thornton, Morlather, Kostrack, Weinstein, and Arledge.

FEB 14 -- Three missions gave us a busy day to day. The first mission escorted some 0-47's to their target and the continued on to bomb and nearly destroy two small towns. Filots were: Carbine, Tuite, Clary, kalen, Horlacher, Kostrah, Frisbie, Arledge, Kerr, Leavoy, and Fein.

The second mission concentrated on an WT depot at Ahrweiler, destrying most of the buildings and at least eight vehicles. On the mission were: Krause, Le Grand, Lewis, Hord, Yandel, Thornton, Bauer, Hunt, Soo, and Mogan.

The third mission did great damage to the often bombed marshalling yards at Neun-kirchen. On this mission were: Carbine, Woodworth, Clary, Kalen, Barker, Morowitz, Weinstein, Sharp, Kerr, and Halpin.

Squadrone Orders No. 5 of this date releive Lt Sundlach of his daties as thit war Bond Officer and appoint him Savings Officer.

WEB 15 -- Jood weather dontinued today permitting three more missions. They did an extredely accurate job of bombing on the marshalling yards at Nonweiler and Muhlfield. There were many cuts scored on the rails and about seventeen cars were destroyed. Krause, Woodworth, Patrick, Halpin, Lewis, Hord, Sharp, and Thornton, took part.

Concurrently with the first mission, Bauer, Lesvoy, Hogan, and Kalen dropped leaflet bombs in the Bitburg area on an uneventful mission.

The third mission, which took-off late in the afternoon, supported units of the XX Corps. It bombed several targets immediately in front of the lines with great accuracy but undisclosed results. Mission pilots were: Carbine, Tuite, Yandel, Uterhart, Clary, Le Grand, Weinstein, Horowitz, Kerr, Hunt, Soo, and Koenig.

Report Number 42 of the IX TAC Victory Oredits Board places the claims of Lt demilton to one FW 190 damaged west of Cologne on 2 Docember 1944 in the unconfirmed category. One 100 destroyed and one FW 100 damaged on the same date were awarded on Report No 36.
Report Number 56 of the XIX AC confirms the damage of one FW 100 by Lt Autoherson on 16 Jan . Lt Autoherson was shot down in this encounter.

FEB 16 -- Both of today's missions piled up substantial totals of destroyed Jerman armor and transportation facilities. The first mission did great damage in the marshalling yerd at Jerolatein both to rolling stock and repair facilities. In additions at least thirty-six ermored vehicles, the majority of which were tanks, were thoroughly strafed and probably destroyed. Jarbins, Tuite, Uterhart, Barker, Tandel, Halpin, Herr, Le Jrand, Soo, and Munt were on the mission.

The accord mission destroyed thirty-one motor transports and ten rail cars as well as several buildings at hyllburg. hrause, frice, fatrick, Fauley, Lewis, Mord, and Sharp took part.

Group Special Orders No. 16 of this date assign three new pilots to this squadron. They are 2nd Lts Duncan A. Johnston, Charles L. Knoochuizen and Jack D. Laubaugh.

FEB 18 -- Continued bad weather kept all planes grounded.

FEB 12 -- The targets for today's first mission were two rail bridges north east of Cochem. The first bridgem was not hit, but the bombs virtually wiped out the small town of Schuld close by. Two or three hits were scored on the second bridge, and at least one span was beldived destroyed. Mission pilots were: Krause, Price, Le Grand, Clary, Kohig, Patrick, and Uterhart.

The second mission was uneventful as far as positive results that could be determined from observation. It consisted of bombing and strafing two small towns which were said to contain German Command Posts. Carbine, Woodworth, Kalen, and Halpin took part.

A Memorandum from Group of this date gives details on the besidest which Ltiamilton went to Faris on 5 February to make. The program was broadcast over the Blue Net work from Los Angeles in the "Soldiers With Wings" series. It was one of the few direct pick-ups ever made in Faris other than regular net work reporteds. The script included background material on the landing in Normandy by the swuadron. It also included the awarding of the Presidential Citation to the 566th Group and descriptions of the great achievements of 3 September 1944 and 22 January by the group. A personality sketch, based on interviews by correspondents at SHAEF with Lt Hamilton, was syndicated in 1700 newspapers throughout the United States. A representative from "Air Force" magazine also got mention from Lt Hamilton for an article on the Babo Angils" for the April issue. It Hamilton was mentioned in the Chicago Tribune, 25 January in connection with the story of the Ninth Air Force stracks of 22 January.

FLD 20 -- Today's only mission bombed barges in dock areas at Gernseheim. Eleven barges were destroyed and five demaged. Major Tuite destroyed three of four railroad cars with one bomb and Major Carbines flight damaged twenty-five more cars. On this mission were: Carbine, Frice, Mogan, Le Grand, Barker, Mostrach, fauley, Arledge, Lewis, Munt, Fein, Wright, Kerr, Tuite, Yandel, and Horowitz.

\* SQUADRON'S BUSIEST DAY \*\* Today was by far the busiest in the history of the 397
\* 50 SORTIES \*\* 21 F22 45 \* Fighter Squadron. Fourteen missions were flown and sixty
\* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* individual sorties. Thirty tons of bombs were dropped on e
enemy territory. One of the most surprising features of the day was that there were no
losses and no Lamage due to enemy action nor were there any shortives, which reflects great
credit on the men who service the planes. Our work was all done in support of two corps
of the Third Army. The 12th Corps was pushing down from the north and the 5th Corps was
driving up from the south in an attempt to make a juncture along the Frum River and to out
off the enemy armor and vehicles which remained in the area behind the former Ardennes
salient. It was also an attempt out the communication lines and to destroy the supply
dumps which fed these forces.

A tabulation of the missions and their results is as follows:

6. Kerr, Woodworth, Yandel, and Tuite: Two OF's and eight other buildings destroyed.

 Horlacher, LeGrand, Fatrick, and Helpin: A rail bridge near Cochem probably destroyed.

8. Sauer, Frice, Weinstein, and Fein: Ten MT and six houses destroyed.
9. Krause, Shea, Frisbie, and Hunt: Three houses, eight MT, three guns destroyed, one tank damaged.

10. Clary, Koenig, Sherp, Arledge: Two tanks destroyed, four damaged, three MT destroyed.

11. Lewis, Wright, Baker Uterhart: Two buildings, one AT destroyed, 6 damaged, troops strafed.

12. Carbine, Leavey, Fauley, and Kostrach: One town destroyed, two tanks damaged nine MT destroyed and nine damaged.

13. Parker, Mord, Yandel, and Tuite: One tank destroyed, one damaged.
14. Kerr, woodworth, Fein, Fatrick, Horlacher, Frice, Weinstein, and Hunt: At

least 25 buildings destroyed and one of. One tank and four all destroyed.

FEE 22 -- Today our squadron cooperated in an all our effort of planes of the 5th and 9th Air Fores to paralyze all rail taffic in western sermany. Over 5000 aircraft took part flying over 5000 sorties. Our group acted as escort to mediums out to several bridges just west of the Rhine. 108 fighters redez-voused with 109 mediums over Metz. The target for our squadron was two rail bridges at Steckweiler. Our planes scored several hits on on both bridges and did more damage than the mediums which they escorted. Filots were: Carbine, Frice, Tuite, Leavoy, Bauer, hoenig, Fauley, Forter (100th Ftr Wing), Kerr, Woodworth, fandel, and Wright.

In an all star game which featured the Gp EN All Stars and GF All Star Officers the EN came out victorious by a score of 56 to 55. This was a hard contested game but the EN's gained the initiative and held it for the remainder of the game.




